BLAH BLAH BLAH Phonics Card Game

Blah Blah Blah is the card game that makes phonics fun! Race to get rid of your cards by matching sounds and letters, and playing wild cards to trip up your opponents. Master decoding words using phonics with these three decks of cards, ranging from easy to more difficult. Every card shows a word consisting of three letters (or groups of letters), e.g. b-o-x, b-oo-k, p-i-ck. Each player takes seven cards. One card is placed face-up on the table with the rest of the deck in a pile, face-down. Players must play a card from their hand that contains at least one of the letters that are in the word on the table. The first player to get rid of all their cards wins. But beware! Wild cards hidden in the deck can force you to skip your turn or draw more cards. Bonus feature: each card has a QR code at the back to help you pronounce the sounds.

Whiz Kids Reading Fun Kits 1-4

by Louise Park

Ages: 4+

These carefully levelled kits make learning to read and spell a breeze. Each fold out folder contains 3 books to read, 3 sheets of magnets for spelling and word fun and 12 flashcards to support learning. Filled with lots of games and activities to help your child recognise words and write them. The kits are designed to help your child learn to read using synthetic phonics. Each of the decodable readers in the kit introduces a set of sounds and letters, and features decodable words that your child will be able to read when they've learnt those sounds. The readers also include specific sight words for your child to learn.

The flashcards in the kit contain the sight words featured in all three readers; they can be used as a companion to the readers, to help your child remember those words on sight. Finally, also included is a set of 72 magnetic letters, which your child can use to form their own words, and even play the word games that you'll find on the inside cover of this pack.

Using synthetic phonics as presented in this kit, in preparation for your child starting school or as a complement to their learning at school, you'll be surprised at how quickly they can progress in their reading and writing. Super-fun kits that children will love to explore and succeed with.
